

SAGA Trip to Schulenburg (55+)



The Painted Churches in Schulenburg, TX is a guided tour of five churches. It's a fascinating tour with details on the German, Czech and Polish settlements in Texas during the 1840s and 1850s. SAGA invites anyone 55 and up to take a trip and see some of the magnificent churches built and painted by these early settlers.

We will depart by bus from the FMC South parking lot (Pumpkin Patch) at 8am on May 23rd and will stop for lunch at a fast-food restaurant. **This lunch is not included in the trip.** We will arrive in Schulenburg mid-afternoon. Dinner on the 23rd will be at Sengelmann Hall and is included in the price. We will spend the night at the Holiday Inn Express in Schulenburg (20 rooms with 2 double beds and 5 rooms with a king bed have been blocked). A full breakfast is included. The hotel is included in the price, however **you are responsible for reserving your room.** Contact Sam at the hotel at 979-743-2301. We will stop for a lunch buffet included in the price at the Oak Ridge Smokehouse.

- Cost per person for the trip is \$230 which includes double occupancy at the hotel or \$305 for a room with single occupancy
- Non-refundable deposit of \$50 is due at the time your reservation is made
- Final payments are due by May 13th
- Waiver must be completed by May 13th

The cost of the trip includes: bus, hotel, two meals, (dinner and lunch), ticket to churches, and tips.
